The **Inclusive STEM Teaching Project** is an online course paired with a Learning Community designed to advance the awareness, self-efficacy, and ability of faculty, postdocs, and doctoral students to cultivate inclusive STEM learning environments for all their students and to develop themselves as reflective, inclusive practitioners.

Your time commitment would be:

1. **Course:** self-paced learning (14-21 hours of online course instruction, either in line with weekly Learning Community meetings or at your own pace)
2. **Community:** 2 hours per week in a weekly virtual meeting for 7 weeks (Thursdays, 12-2, June 6-July 25)
3. **Continue:** as designed and desired with quarterly check ins and opportunities to engage
